

Evergreen Trees

Balsam fir (*Abies balsamea*): used for Christmas trees and as an ornamental • mature height 75' • moist, fertile soils • full to partial sun • soft, bright green needles with pleasant fragrance • 'Provenance 70'

Tamarack (*Larix laricina*): hard wood durable in soil, used for posts, poles and pulpwood • reaches 60' tall • deciduous conifer • grows in wet soils, but also uplands • golden yellow autumn color

White cedar (*Thuja occidentalis*): used for screening or windbreaks mature height 40' • moist to well-drained soils • full to partial sun aromatic needles, small cones • deer may browse • 'Affinity'

White pine (*Pinus strobus*): average height 75' • moist to well-drained soils • full to partial sun • soft green needles 3 to 5" long and 5 to 8" cones • a source of food for deer, so may need protection

White spruce (*Picea glauca*): used for Christmas trees, wind breaks, and as ornamentals • mature height 70' • moist, fertile soils • full to partial sun • stiff, green needles

Deciduous Trees

Red maple (*Acer rubens*): all parts used by wildlife • mature height 40 to 65' • tolerates a wide range of conditions • bright red in autumn • narrow rounded crown

Sugar maple (*Acer saccharum*): official state tree of Wisconsin • mature height 80' • rich, moist soil • leaves break down quickly to make rich organic fertilizer

Bur oak (*Quercus macrocarpa*): source of food for wildlife • mature height 80' • moist, well-drained soil • resembles white oak

Red oak (*Quercus rubra*): wide, massive shade tree • provides food for turkey, blue jay and ruffed grouse • mature height 70' • prefers dry uplands • leaves turn red in autumn • acorns have smooth caps

Swamp white oak (*Quercus bicolor*): 65 to 80 feet tall • moist, fertile soil, including swamps • acorns eaten by squirrels, wood ducks and other wildlife • tolerates light shade

Shrubs

American plum (*Amelanchier canadensis*): Can be grown as a tree or shrub • mature height is 15 to 25' • bears white flowers in spring • yellow to red fruit in June and July • grows best in rich, moist soil

Chokecherry (*Prunus virginiana*): shrub or small tree • mature height 15 to 20' • grows along streams, open woods, cut-over and bushy areas • dark purple drupes with large seed are loved by birds

Elderberry (*Sambucus canadensis*): open, many-stemmed, broad, round shrub • spreading branches • 5' to 15' • fruit eaten by mammals and birds • full sunlight • moist to slightly dry soil

Juneberry (*Amelanchier canadensis*): provides food for birds mature height 8' • prefers well-drained, rich soil, but grows in clay • sun to semi-shade • white flower clusters followed by purple fruit

Ninebark (*Physocarpus opulifolius*): slow-growing, reaching 10' in 20 years • prefers sun, tolerates wide range of soils • multi-stemmed • provides excellent wildlife cover and food
